The **Teen Research Internship Program (TRIP)** is a rigorous laboratory-based course for high school students who are motivated to explore their interests in **science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM)**.

The **mission** of TRIP is to foster enthusiasm for science by offering students a chance to conduct hypothesis-driven research and hands-on learning in a laboratory. In addition, students engage with Fox Chase faculty and staff during one-on-one mentorship and acquire skills necessary for team building, resiliency, and leadership, by joining a growing family of driven and curious students.
